Test of Academic Skills (TEAS) - https://www.atitesting.com/teas-prep

The TEAS is a required test for students submitting application to both the HACC Nursing and Dental Hygiene programs. The TEAS measures basic essential skills in the academic content area domains of reading, mathematics, science and English and language usage. The TEAS includes 150 scored and 20 unscored, pretest items with a 209-minute time limit. Question types include multiple choice, multiple select (select all that apply), fill in the blank, ordered response and hot spots.

- The TEAS test was updated to Version 7 June 2022.
- Beginning fall 2023 ONLY Version 7 tests are accepted.
- TEAS 7 scores are valid for 3 years.
- Effective March 1, 2024- all <u>nursing</u> TEAS testing must be completed in person on a HACC campus. Students who live outside the region can register for the TEAS **In-Person Proctored by PSI.**
- Effective May 1, 2024- all <u>dental hygiene</u> TEAS testing must be completed in person on a HACC campus. Students who live outside the region can register for the TEAS **In-Person Proctored by PSI.**




HOW TO REGISTER FOR THE TEAS

TEAS tests are given in person at the Gettysburg, Harrisburg, Lancaster, and York campuses, and you may register for any HACC location.


- Go to the ATI website and navigate to the online TEAS store (https://www.atitesting.com/teas)
- Select In-Person Proctored by an Institution (HACC) (OR In-Person Proctored by PSI for out of area students)



<u>Program Type</u> doesn't matter (TEAS for Nursing Students or TEAS for Allied Health). Select <u>Search by SCHOOL NAME (or PSI Testing Center if out of the area)</u>



Select your preferred HACC test site



- Effective March 1, 2024- all <u>nursing</u> (May 1, 2024 for <u>dental hygiene</u>) TEAS testing must be completed in person on a HACC campus. If a student cannot be confirmed as attending a TEAS testing session, at a campus face to face testing session, the score will not be seen as valid. A TEAS score completed in a remote setting will not be accepted. Please sign up early for a testing session.
 - Students who live outside the region can register for the TEAS In-Person Proctored by PSI. contact a
- The cost of the TEAS taken at HACC is around \$101 plus tax (subject to change). (\$120 at PSI)
- **Testing accommodations** are available for the TEAS exam. Reference the Important Information (below) for details.
- You will receive an email confirmation with your receipt and testing session information.
- HACC will also send an email 1-2 days prior to your exam appointment with specific test-day information. This email will be sent to the email address you provide ATI! Be sure to check spam or junk if you use an email address other than Hawkmail.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- Applicants to HACC Nursing program must achieve a TEAS composite score of 70 if applying to the Associate Degree (RN)
 program and 60 if applying to the PN program.
- Applicants to the HACC dental hygiene program must achieve a TEAS composite score of 62.
 - FOR DENTAL HYGIENE Three attempts in an application cycle is permitted for the TEAS exam. Scores are
 acceptable for three (3) years.
- In the event students want to remediate and retest, it is recommended to wait 45 days between tests so, remediation can take place. Students should not take more than 3 tests in an application period.
- TEAS scores are valid for 3 years.
- The TEAS test (and your score) is the same whether you indicate TEAS for Nursing or TEAS for Allied Health.
- Testing accommodations are available for the TEAS exam. HACC students already receiving testing accommodations should connect with their SAS coordinator to review and discuss at least one week prior to registering for the TEAS exam.
