College announces new 65+ program

Central Pennsylvania's senior citizens can continue their life-long learning with HACC's new 65+ program. It allows seniors to audit most credit courses for free, if they meet pre-requisites and placement testing requirements.

To participate, you must be at least 65 years of age and be a permanent resident of Adams, Cumberland, Dauphin, Franklin, Fulton, Juniata, Lancaster, Lebanon, Mifflin, Perry, Schuylkill or York County. If you are interested in auditing a credit course this fall, register in person at the HACC campus offering the course no more than five days before the start of the term (August 23).
