- **Photovoltaic Systems**, a basic introduction to solar energy, is a 20-hour course that will run from 7:30-9:30 a.m. Tuesdays and Thursdays, Aug. 11-Sept. 10. This course is for the professional contractor who has some mechanical and electrical knowledge.
- **Elec-tricked: Watt Can I Do?** Evaluate your home through the eyes of an energy pro during this two-hour course. *Date for the course to be determined*. Students will learn how to make small changes for big energy savings.
- **Home Energy Smart: Where Do I Start?** Residential homeowners who are considering an energy efficiency make-over will benefit from this course. *Date for the course to be determined*. Instructors are Bonnie McCann and Jennifer Briggs from Waste Not Energy Advisors.
