The HACC Alumni Association welcomes applications for the 2012-2013 scholarships honoring Dr. Clyde E. Blocker, the first president, and Mr. Maurice G. Overholt, the first business officer.

The scholarships are awarded in the amount of a full year's sponsoring district tuition, fees, and a \$100 book allowance to students who have financial need, good academic records, and community and/or HACC organizational involvement.

To be eligible, a student must have completed at least 24 HACC credit hours by the end of the spring semester 2010 and be starting their sophomore year at HACC. The recipient must be a full-time student at HACC during the entire academic year of 2012-2013. If a student falls below 12 credits, this will cause a loss of scholarship funds.

To select the recipients, the Scholarship Review Committee will use the attached application form. Other support materials may also be included.

A *current* Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) must be completed and the results on file in the Financial Aid Office by April 1, 2012. The Scholarship Review Committee may also require a personal interview.

The scholarship will be awarded without regard to an applicant's sex, race, creed, color, national origin, age, non-job-related handicap, or veteran status.
