Lisa Moreno is a familiar face to many residents of Adams County. Since April 2007, she has served as an Adams County commissioner. She is only the second woman ever elected to this prestigious position.

Lisa is one of three administrators of the county government, which encompasses registration and elections, assessment of persons and property, human services, veterans' affairs, appointment of county personnel and fiscal management. As a commissioner, her primary duty is to create and manage the annual budget.

The 2000 HACC graduate spends considerable time serving the Gettysburg region. She is a member of the Adams County Cooperative Extension Board of Directors, the Adams County Transit Authority Board of Directors, Adams County Economic Development Board of Directors, the Local Emergency Planning Commission, and the Pennsylvania Counties Risk Pool Board of Directors. Previously, Lisa held various positions in county government and was a licensed realtor with Jack Gaughen Realty in Gettysburg.

Since graduation, the HACC-Gettysburg alumna has also stayed engaged in her campus.
