This program serves as a foundation for students who plan to transfer to professional art and photography schools. Some students may wish to pursue the program for personal enrichment rather than as a transfer program. HACC has transfer agreements with the Rochester Institute of Technology and other leading schools. **PLEASE NOTE, these agreements offer assistance in planning required course work, however, the ultimate admission into a transfer program and acceptance of course credits is based on an individual's portfolio review.** Since the requirements of transfer institutions vary widely, it is essential to choose a transfer school as soon as possible in order to ensure maximum transfer credits. Some students may find the Art and Design – Visual Arts (# 2130) is more suitable for the transfer school of your choice.

Extensive Program changes have occurred. Students are asked to work with their faculty advisor to insure they are enrolled in the proper courses. Some of the advanced courses, i.e., ART 206, will be Closed to all registrants. Chair of department must determine student's eligibility for course enrollment prior to permission for enrollment.
