- Alvernia has a rolling admissions policy but you should apply one semester prior to transfer. Transfer students are also required to submit official HACC (or other college) transcripts and financial aid transcripts.
- Minimum GPA requirement: With completion of HACC Liberal Arts Social Science AA – 2.0
- The FAFSA application is used by Alvernia. If student is transferring to begin at Alvernia in the January term both HACC and Alvernia need to be identified on the Fall FAFSA.
