

Transfer Institution: Albright College Accelerated Degree Completion Program (DCP)

DCP Admission requirements are as follows: 1) applicants must be 23 years of age or older; 2) must have 5 years of full-time documented work or volunteer experience; 3) must have an associate degree or a minimum of 48 transferable college credits (including English 101); 4) must have basic computer technology proficiency; 5) must complete application and send official transcripts. **Please note:** Career and transfer degrees are accepted. Degrees designed from transfer receive core-to-core credit.

General Studies (#7660) AA degree at HACC (61 credits)

This major at HACC will satisfy requirements for the Albright College Accelerated DCP in **any of the Accelerated Degree Programs with proper advising.** Any certificate, diploma or AA program at HACC can be incorporated into the DCP programs through this major. Special attention should be shown to the General Education Requirements of the DCP programs to make sure they are part of this degree. You must follow the recommended courses if you wish to transfer with no loss of credits. The bold notations in parenthesis, i.e. **(ENGL - 1)** are the Albright College Accelerated DCP requirements.

3. A minimum GPA of 2.0 is required.
