\* Foreign Language requirement: 2 courses at the intermediate level 201, 202. Exceptions: 101 and 102 may be used if you: a) wish to begin a new language, b) had less than 2 years of the language in high school, c) have had no language study in 5 years.

**Special Notes:**

- 1) 0-level courses do **not** count toward graduation credits and they do **not** transfer.
- 2) Minimum GPA to apply is 2.5; admission is selective. Recommended application date: Fall, March 1; Spring, Nov. 1. Must include transcript.
- 3) Education students will need to pass the PRAXIS I Pre-Professional Skills Test before they can be admitted to the Education Advanced Professional Studies block at LVC. It is suggested that you take these tests during the semester prior to transfer to LVC. You may include the LVC college code (2364) on your application so the official scores are sent directly to LVC at no charge.
- 4) Courses for LVC have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and LVC. However, curricula are subject to change and it is in your best interest to speak with your advisor and/or the LVC transfer advisor if you have any questions. Courses that are “recommended” complete not only HACC requirements, but also LVC general education requirements and/or major requirements. It is in your best interest to take the recommended courses.
