- 3) Technology Education majors are encouraged to take EDUC 110, ENGL 201-207 (select one) PSYC 101 and 201. Minimum GPA for Educ. Majors: 3.0.
- 4) Admissions is competitive so apply early: Fall application deadline - Feb 1 (must include transcript)
Spring application deadline - July 1 (must include transcript)
- 5) Admission to MU's Education Advanced Professional Studies is not granted automatically. Students must successfully complete the PRAXIS I Pre-Professional Skills Test and meet other curriculum requirements before they can be admitted to the Education Advanced Professional Studies block at MU. **It is suggested that you take these tests prior to 45 credits.** Students must also have satisfactory Act 34 (Criminal Record Check), Act 114 (FBI Fingerprint), and Act 151(Child Abuse) reports.
