**Special Notes:**

- 1) Courses for Millersville University have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and MU based on current academic year. Curricula are subject to change. It is the students' responsibility to speak with their advisor for any changes or updates.
- 2) 0-level courses do **not** count toward graduation credits and they do **not** transfer.
- 3) You will need to pass the PRAXIS I Pre-Professional Skills Test before you can be admitted to the Education Advanced Professional Studies at MU. **Students are strongly encouraged to complete PRAXIS I prior to 45 credits.** Students must also have satisfactory Act 34 (Criminal Record Check), Act 114 (FBI Fingerprint), and Act 151(Child Abuse) reports.
- 4) BSEd majors are required to have a minimum 3.0 GPA.
- 5) The above courses complete not only HACC requirements, but also Millersville general education requirements, major requirements and/or writing specific areas. It is in your best interest to take the recommended courses.
- 6) Admissions is competitive so apply **early**: Fall application deadline - Feb 1 (must include transcript)
