**Special Notes:**

- 0-Level courses **do not** count toward graduation requirements and **will not transfer**. HD courses do not transfer.
- All students completing a Bachelor of Arts at SU are required to attain intermediate level proficiency in a foreign language. This may be satisfied by completion of three years of a foreign language in high school, three credits of 200-level college coursework in foreign language or satisfactory completion of an intermediate level proficiency examination.
- Students will need to pass the PRAXIS I Pre-professional Skills Test before they can be admitted to the Professional Semester block at SU. It is suggested that you take these tests during the semester prior to completion of 48 cr.
