TROPICAL ECOLOGY IN THE BAHAMAS

EXPLORE THE BAHAMAS...

Ever wonder what the world was like back in the days of Ernest Hemingway? Here's your chance to see first hand, a nearly pristine lightly populated tropical island. The Tropical Ecology of the Bahamas will explore a remote tropical island while learning the science of modern ecology.

You will travel to San Salvador, thought to be where Christopher Columbus first made landfall. San Salvador houses roughly 1,000 people, yet is approximately as large as the main tourist island of Nassau. Due to the light population, the island houses healthy and extensive coral reefs, tropical flora and fauna, seagrass beds, and mangrove forests.

We will spend seven days at The Gerace Research Centre, which specializes in hosting students studying island ecology. After you conduct your own research project, students will experience the main island of Nassau, visit Paradise Island and explore the marine life at the Atlantis Aquarium.
