ANNUAL FINANCIAL REQUIREMENTS
FOR INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Showing adequate funding available to pay for your tuition, fees, and living expenses is an important part of your application for an I-20 document and for your visa. The school fees and living expenses listed below are the estimated cost for a student to attend HACC for one year. You are required to submit bank statements and affidavit of supports from your sponsor(s) showing proof that you have this amount of funding available.

These amounts are per year and are based on a 12 credit academic schedule for both the fall and spring semesters. The charge for each additional credit beyond 12 is \$307.50/credit (based on 2016-2017 rate.) Summer school tuition is not included.

ESTIMATED LIVING COSTS

Average living costs for a 12-month year are estimated below. This is a modest “no extras” budget. It does not include such items as telephone calls, for example. It is highly recommended that you bring approximately 20% extra.

DEPENDENT COSTS

If you are going to be accompanied by a spouse or a child you must show additional funds:

- **\$5,500** for your spouse and **\$3,000** for each child.

These costs do not include medical insurance that is estimated at **\$3600 a year** for your spouse and **\$1350 a year** for each child. **Please NOTE:** Exact amounts for medical insurance depend on the policy and coverage chosen and the age of your spouse.

REFUND POLICY
