- Submitted paperwork for request for funds for Wisp Mountain for \$225 (15 students @ \$15.00 each). Wisp Mountain ski day has been switched from a Wednesday to Thursday, January 14th due to a conflict with the bus.
- Club members decided not to fund the Advantage Card of \$20 per student.
- No report from interclub
- Mrs. Bittle presented the estimated costs for a trip to Vermont. The quote for a 46 passenger bus to drive to Vermont on Sunday, March 7th and return to

Gettysburg on Thursday, March 11th is \$4,000 (includes a \$100 bus driver tip). Stratton Mountain provided prices for lodging in a hotel and condo. The Inn Hotel's estimate was \$275.46 per person, with 2 people staying in one room. This price includes 4 nights lodging, 4 continental breakfasts, 3 days of lift tickets. The costs for the condos were higher. If we filled the bus with 46 people, the total lodging cost would be \$12,671.12. Take this amount and add the \$4,000 bus cost, the total trip would cost \$16,671.12 or a \$362.26 per person cost. After presenting this material, it was decided by the members of the club to present this material to the student life council to see how much money we can request. All officers of the club agreed to be at the meeting on November 11th.
