We held our first meeting today. For those who missed it, here's what happened.

Our Next meeting will be Wednesday, September 30 at 1:00 pm.

If you were in attendance at today's meeting, I have your information. If you were not in attendance, please reply in an email so I can update our list of members.

Every club must perform a community service. It was decided that we will try to borrow the snow cone machine from Ski Liberty and sell snow cones to students on one Wednesday in October. This will promote SNOW activities for our Snow Ski/Board club. All donations will go to United Way. Brooke Flohr is going to look into getting the snow cone machine. Once we know when the machine will be available, we will select a date at our next meeting.

We reviewed our schedule of activities. We need to create a financial request for each event. Treasurer, Josh Haynes and I will work up a proposal for each event and present them for voting at our September 30th meeting. If you want to have input into how we spend our money for the club, you will want to attend this meeting.

Every club must have an Inter-club Committee member. Josh King has volunteered to be our committee member. Thanks Josh.

We reviewed the Night Club Cards. Prices for this year did not increase from last year. Night club cards allow the skier/boarder to ski or board any night from January 3rd until the end of the season at any of the three resorts (Ski Liberty, Ski Roundtop, or Whitetail). Prices for NCC are \$169 for Lift tickets, \$214 for Lift and Lesson, \$249 for Lift, Lesson and Rentals. There is an optional \$20 advantage card which will give you a 40% discount on lift tickets if you wish to ski/board during the day or before January 3rd. NCC are due by November 1st. More information and forms will be distributed at the next meeting. We will advertise the NCC in the creative cannon.

We talked a little about the trip to Stratton Mountain in Vermont over midterm break. As more information becomes available, a follow up discussion will occur.

Our Treasurer, Jon Youngbar is not a registered student this semester, so we will need to elect a new Vice President at our next meeting.
