III. Approval of Agenda:

- Representative Bullis motioned to approve and Representative Martin seconded. The motion carried with a unanimous vote.

IV. New Business:

- a) Bill No. 1: Amanda Batista – Batista explained why she thought she should be appointed as a Representative. Representative Bullis motioned to approve and Representative Martin seconded. The bill passed with a unanimous vote.
- b) Bill No. 2: Darin Robillard – Representative Reed motioned to approve and Representative Martin seconded. The bill passed with a unanimous vote.
- c) Bill No. 3: Amber Zambrana – Representative Jones motioned to approve and Representative Vera seconded. The bill passed with a unanimous vote.
- d) Bill No. 4: Vice President Appointment – Representative Anwar motioned to approve and Representative Robillard seconded. The bill passed with a unanimous vote.
- e) Bill No. 5: Secretary Appointment – Representative Jones motioned to approve and Representative Robillard seconded. The bill passed with a unanimous vote.
- f) Bill No. 6: Community Involvement Chair Appointment – Representative Martin motioned to approve and Representative Bullis seconded. The bill passed with a unanimous vote.
- g) Bill No. 7: Public Relations Chair Appointment – Representative Batista motioned to approve and Representative Martin seconded. The bill passed with a unanimous vote.
- h) Bill No. 8: Fall Free for All – Tina Gill and Jean Tucker explained that the Fall Free for All is an event that will be held on September 8th and is designed to introduce students to clubs and student services on campus. They explained that there is no budget for the event so it is dependent on donations to fund the food and DJ for the event. Jean Tucker said that she would welcome ideas from students for the event and said that students could find her in Cooper

- j) Help for the Homeless – Representative Robillard explained that he had attended HACC’s Hunger and Homelessness Service-Learning Program and had an idea for having a homelessness fundraiser on campus. He said that the tentative date was Wednesday, November 17th and that the event would include getting speakers from the National Coalition for the Homeless and having a soup dinner. He explained that the money fundraised would go to the Bethesda Mission or another local charity. He asked for support from fellow SGA members in planning the event and said that anyone who was interested in getting involved should give him their email address.
