Paramedic Certificate Program - 37 credits

Paramedic Associate Degree Program - 79 credits

The daytime clinical phase of the certificate and associate degree program will begin mid-February and continue through October 2009. This clinical phase will include 2 to 3 days of classroom/clinical lab sessions at the Harrisburg campus each week. This will be supplemented with 1 to 2 days weekly of specialty clinical rotations through area hospitals and ALS services. Both programs require additional course work which can be completed at the students own pace either before or after the clinical portion.
