

# Nursing Programs Consolidation Announcement – January 2012



## Lebanon Campus Advanced Standing Nursing Program (LPN to RN) Option

Effective immediately (February 2012 application cycle), Lebanon students applying for the Advanced Standing option of the Associate Degree Nursing program will apply for the program at the Harrisburg or Lancaster Campus selecting Lebanon as their preferred clinical rotation site.

Students selected for the program will attend their specified campus for course work and lab practice. Students from the Lebanon area accepted in to the Advanced Standing option will be considered for the available Lebanon clinical sites.

All prerequisite courses for the nursing program will continue to be offered at the Lebanon Campus.

## Gettysburg/Harrisburg Campus Practical Nursing Program

In January 2013 , the Gettysburg campus Practical Nursing program will combine with the Harrisburg Campus program. Beginning with the August 2012 application cycle, Gettysburg students will apply to the Harrisburg Campus program selecting Gettysburg as their preferred clinical site.

Sixty-six (66) students will be selected for the Harrisburg Campus Practical Nursing program. All will attend classroom instruction and nursing skills laboratory practice at the Harrisburg Campus. Sixteen (16) students will be assigned to Gettysburg area sites for clinical rotations. Fifty (50) students will be assigned to Harrisburg area sites for clinical rotations.

All prerequisite courses for the practical nursing program will continue to be offered at the Gettysburg Campus.
