Health Science is a selective admission degree completion program **designed for actively credentialed or licensed health care professionals currently working in their fields**. Credential verification and employment verification letter are required. Qualified applicants will be awarded 30 credits toward the Health Science degree.

You may transfer a maximum of 15 credits from previous colleges. Submit official transcripts to the Records Office.

Students who are NOT actively credentialed health care professionals currently working in their fields may be interested in the Health Care Management degree. You can see an advisor to change your major.
