American Heart Association

Prerequisite: Students must provide the AHA Online Completion certificate which is available upon completion of Part 1 of the Heartcode Online course (www.onlineaha.org). The Heartcode course is designed for those seeking certification outside of the classroom setting. This course covers the didactic portion of the traditional ACLS program including interactive case based scenarios. Upon successful completion of the online module, the student should print out the completion certificate. After setting up an appointment, the student must bring the completion certificate to the appointment, at which time the student will have the ability to practice skills, followed by a skills test delivered by an AHA ACLS instructor. Emphasis is on aggressive assessment and treatment of children in respiratory or cardiac arrest. This program also stresses the initial management and care issues of trauma and transfer. *Tuition includes the AHA PALS textbook.*
