Basic Life Support for Healthcare Providers covers core material such as adult and pediatric one and two-rescuer CPR, use of a face shield and a bag mask to deliver ventilation support to patients, foreign-body airway management, and using an automated external defibrillator. The target audience for this program is the healthcare provider, or student entering the healthcare field, also EMS personnel, physician assistants, doctors, dentists, nurses, and respiratory therapists. A written exam and a skills test are required for successful course completion.

Tuition includes an AHA CPR BLS textbook.
