### **Why do students under the age of 18 need a parent or guardian present at the first lab session?**

The first lab session begins with an orientation session and the PA State DOH requires parents or guardians to sign documents that a minor would otherwise not be able to sign. The parent or guardian is not required to stay for the whole lab session.

### **What will be required online?**

The online course content is comprised of self-paced modules, videos, case studies, quizzes, and tests. Each assignment has a deadline, may be timed and will be graded. You will be provided with a course syllabus at the first lab session and will know what is required of you every week.

### **How do I access the online portion of the EMT class?**

You can only access the online platform with a HAWKMAIL log-in. If you do not have a HAWKMAIL email address, one will be provided for you which can be found on the back of your confirmation letter along with your temporary password. If your confirmation letter does not have this information, please call 717-780-2570, the Help Desk, and they will help you get your email set up. **You may not access the online content until the first day of class.**

### **Are the dates listed the only days I have to log in online?**

No, the dates listed are when you need to report to the lab site for your practical sessions. You should log in to the course as often as possible so as not to miss any deadlines, assignments, and quizzes.

### **What are the uniform requirements?**

HACC provides the students with one uniform shirt at the first lab session. The student is responsible for obtaining the remainder of the uniform which consists of navy blue work pants (ex. BDUs), black work boot type shoes, and a black belt. Students must be in uniform for every lab session.
