The Heartsaver AED course teaches CPR, AED and their use in relief of choking in adults and children. Infant CPR is also covered, with relief of choking and use of barrier devices for all ages. This course is designed for individuals who have a duty to respond to a cardiac emergency, respond to an emergency while at work, or regulatory requirements.

Does not meet the requirements for healthcare providers. Skills testing is required for course completion. There is no written test for this course.
