

Fire Training Facility & Prop Fee Schedule



These fees are included in training contract proposals or Local Level class costs.

Structural Burn Building Use Costs

4 Hours (Non-Live Fire) \$125

4 Hours (Live Fire)* \$250

8 Hours (Non-Live Fire) \$250

8 Hours (Live Fire)* \$500

Flammable Gas Fire / Car Fire Props

4 Hours (Live Fire)* \$250

8 Hours (Live Fire)* \$500

Drill Tower \$175 = 4 Hours / \$350 = 8 Hours

Smoke Chamber \$125 = 4 Hours / \$250 = 8 Hours

Roof Simulator \$ 75 = 4 Hours / \$150 = 8 Hours

Vehicle Training Rescue Pad \$125 = 4 Hours / \$250 = 8 Hours

Vehicles to cut \$100 each

Hazardous Materials Training Area \$125 = 4 Hours / \$250 = 8 Hours

Pump Training Pad \$125 = 4 hours / \$250 = 8 Hours

Technical Rescue Area \$125 = 4 Hours / \$250 8 Hours

(Trench, Collapse & Confined Space Areas)

Plywood \$ 25 per sheet

Liquid Smoke \$ 35 per quart

Dry Chemical Fire Extinguishers \$ 20 each

Smoke Machine Rental \$ 25 each

Firefighting Foam \$ 22 per gallon (\$110 per 5-gallon pail)

Classroom Space \$100 a day per classroom

Use of Fire Apparatus Use \$50 = 4 hours / \$100 = 8 hours each rig.
