This Addendum is hereby made part of the Plans and Project Manual dated April 29, 2011 for the above referenced project. The provisions of this Addendum are intended to supplement the provisions of the Plans and Project Manual and/or supersede them where contradictory thereto.

This Addendum contains changes to the requirements of the Plans and Project Manual. Such changes shall be incorporated into the Plans and Project Manual and shall apply to work with the same meaning and force as if they had been included in the original Plans and Project Manual. Where this Addendum modifies a portion of a paragraph or phrase of the Project Manual, the remaining unmodified portion of the paragraph or phrase shall remain in force.

The conditions and terms of the Plans and Project Manual shall govern work described in this Addendum. Whenever the conditions of work, or the quality or quantity of materials or workmanship are not fully described in this Addendum, the conditions of work etc. included in the Plans and Project Manual for similar items of work shall apply to the work described in this Addendum. If no similar items of work are included in the Plans and Project Manual, the quality of material and workmanship shall be subject to the written acceptance of the Architect.

1.1 BID DATE RESCHEDULED

Bids received after this time will not be accepted. ONLY BONAFIDE BIDS WILL BE ACCEPTED. Bids will be opened and read aloud immediately following the bid receipt time.

- 1.2 Bid Documents in electronic format are available on CD directly from Eastern PCM for a fee of \$25.00. Changes to the documents have been made; therefore the plans and specifications previously issued under the last bid are not to be used for preparation of bids.
- 1.3 EPCM reviewed the bid form and bid documents found in Division 0 of the Project Manual. Bidders were instructed that the following forms must be submitted with the bid: completed Bid Form, Non-Collusion Affidavit, MBE/WBE Utilization Form and Bid Security.

- 1.5 All questions are to be directed to Justin Kovaleski in the office of the Construction Manager in writing via fax or e-mail: Fax (717) 233-1666, E-mail: epcm@easternpcm.com. The last day for questions is June 8, 2011.
- 1.6 Addendum #1 will be issued on May 27, 2011 which will include the minutes to the pre-bid meeting.
- 1.7 This project is subject to PA Prevailing Wage Rates as described in Specification Section 00820. Certified Payroll Reports will be required to be submitted by all Contractors, subcontractors, and sub-subcontractors.
- 1.8 This project must comply with the PA Steel Procurement Act and Fair Trade Practices Act.
- 1.9 Jeff Straub of Crabtree, Rohrbaugh & Associates explained that this project must achieve a LEED Silver rating. Section 01352 of the Specifications describes in detail the LEED Requirements for the project, i.e.; percentage requirements for recycled content and regional materials. Section 01352 governs all LEED related requirements under Specification Divisions 2-10.
- 1.10 LEED Action plans, LEED Submittal forms, and LEED Progress reports will be required from the successful bidders during project construction.
- 1.11 The Owner will obtain the building permits. All trade specific permits will be the responsibility of the respective contractors.



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- 1.12 RACP has supplied grant funding for this project and as such has numerous requirements for the successful bidders:
 - a. Steel Procurement Act
 - b. Trade Practices Act
 - c. Insurance Requirements
 - d. Pennsylvania Prevailing Wage Act
 - e. Certified Payroll Requirements
 - f. Change Order Requirements

These requirements are described in detail in the Supplementary General Conditions.

1.13 Project Overview

The work will be performed under six (6) Prime Contracts and consists of the construction of a new 47,000 SF Law Enforcement Complex including a 25 lane indoor firing range, administrative areas, classrooms, and support areas; renovations to the existing Training Tower, Smoke Building, and North Hall; installation of a new running track, site props, and training elements; expansion of asphalt drives, parking, and a new entrance off Industrial Road; and the construction of a new pedestrian bridge over Paxton Creek including all related site improvements. The project in its entirety will pursue LEED Silver Certification.

1.14 Phasing Requirements

- a) The Public Safety Center will remain an active campus throughout construction. Classes are held during the daytime, evening, and weekends. Contractors to schedule work so as not to impact Owner activities.
- b) Phase 2 of the site work cannot be started until all approvals are received from the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and U.S. Army Corps of Engineers. Approvals for this phase of the work, which includes site lighting, are expected to be received during November 2011.
- c) The Capital Area GreenBelt path is to remain open for public use at all times. The GreenBelt path will need to be relocated temporarily as necessary.
- d) Off-road, paved vehicle access from the Main Campus to the Public Safety Center site must be maintained at all times.
- 1.15 EPCM displayed a site plan (attached) showing the location of construction offices, contractor parking/staging, dumpsters, construction fencing, and contractor access to the pedestrian bridge area.
- 1.16 Temporary utilities are the responsibility of the contractor. Temporary electric has been installed by the Owner from power shed 18A to EPCM's field office. The selected electrical contractor will be responsible to provide power from that location as needed. The electrical contractor will be responsible for demolition of all temporary power back to power shed 18A. Existing temporary electrical equipment will be returned to the Owner.



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- 1.17 Sales tax is applicable and should be included in each respective contractor's bid price.
- 1.18 Testing, Adjusting, and Balancing will be bid as a separate prime contract.
- 1.19 The most notable change from the last bid is the addition of several add alternates. The architect confirmed that the building footprint has not changed from the last bid. Mr. Straub noted that several other scope changes were made and that an itemized list of changes will be provided via addendum. This list is informational only. Each contractor's bid must be based upon the drawings and specifications.
