This Addendum is hereby made part of the Request for Bid No. 10-51 dated June 9, 2010 for the above referenced bid. The provisions of this Addendum are intended to supplement the provisions and scope of work and/or supersede them where contradictory thereto.

This Addendum contains changes to the requirements of the Scope of Work. Such changes shall be incorporated into the Scope of Work and shall apply to work with the same meaning and force as if they had been included in the original Request for Bid. Where this Addendum modifies a portion of a paragraph or phrase of the Scope of Work, the remaining unmodified portion of the paragraph or phrase shall remain in force.

1) MODIFICATION TO BID FORM:

Replace the Bid Form with Exhibit A – Pricing Sheet (an Excel Spreadsheet found on HACC's website – www.hacc.edu)

2) ANSWERS TO QUESTIONS:

- The price per unit is to include labor for initial startup, connection of cameras to new servers and install/setup of client software on PC's, correct?

Answer: Reference Exhibit A

- Are all existing camera terminations clearly labeled and in the same rooms where new Servers will be installed?

Answer: Most are not labeled but are in the same room

- In part 2) c) – “including PTZ cameras and any necessary remediation” If you are expecting the vendor to convert existing PTZ signals will you provide an inventory of existing PTZ models per campus?

Answer: We use Pelco and Panasonic. We are not certain what type was installed at Lancaster and it may require analysis.

Harrisburg – 1 (Panasonic)

Lancaster – 5 (Unknown)

Lebanon – 0

- Is there a minimum and/or maximum # of hours for on-site training and will that be conducted at each campus?

Answer: It will be conducted at each campus where servers will be purchased. We are relying on the vendor to provide a recommendation as to how much training is necessary

- Is the Service and Support Cost after Warranty based upon a per server cost or the total # of servers? If it is based upon total # of servers will you be able to provide a more precise number between 5 & 10?

Answer: Reference Exhibit A

- The specifications call for installation but there is no place on the bid documents where it can be inserted. We will need the number and types of the servers that will be required at each site plus the number and types of cameras that are to be connected to each server in order to bid this properly.

Answer: Reference Exhibit A. All cameras are analog. Number of servers purchased this fiscal year depends on pricing.

- The specifications call out for licenses for both Pelco and Non-Pelco cameras but there is no place listed to price the licenses.

Answer: Reference Exhibit A

- Raid Devices are called out for in the specifications and in the price sheet but there is not enough of information to price the Raid devices. The specs call for Raid 5 and Raid 10 units but does not give the amount of storage for the Raid units. I think that in this case, your technical staff needs to talk to the manufacturer's rep (Steve Camp 215-208-0205). Pelco does manufacture Raid devices for their equipment and that should be used so everything will be 100% compatible with the Pelco System.

Answer: Reference Exhibit A. Storage requirements should match the requirements listed for the model of servers listed in the RFB.
