

Application for Commonwealth Secondary School Diploma – 30 College Credit Option

A Commonwealth Secondary School Diploma (CSSD) may be issued to any Pennsylvania resident who does not possess a secondary school diploma and who is at least 18 years of age upon presentation of evidence of full matriculation and the satisfactory completion of a minimum of 30 semester hours of study at an accredited institution of postsecondary education located in the United States. An official college transcript is acceptable evidence for award of this diploma.

Note: Applicants ages 16-17 must obtain a letter from their school district superintendent recommending issuance of the diploma in order for it to be issued before the 18th birthday. Diplomas will not be awarded to applicants under age 16.
