This is an excellent opportunity for students to advance their

Spanish language studies and become more marketable in their profession - all while expanding their global horizons. Costa Rica is well known for peace, environmental leadership, and natural beauty. For the duration of the program, you will live with Costa Rican families, attend language classes 5 hours a day (M-F), and participate in fun, enlightening activities. The program is divided among three Costa Rican locations: 2 weeks in San Joaquin de Flores (Heredia), a typical "Tico" town 30 minutes from San Jose; and for the 8-credit participants, a week in the Monteverde region, well known for its commitment to the sustainable development of the community and the conservation of the cloud forest reserves; and a final week on the "Golden Coast" of Playa Flamingo, famous for its white

sand beaches and crystal blue water.
