2. To schedule an appointment:
 - a.) Complete this form and take it to the Test Center Office (RM232E) where the Testing Center Staff will provide you with a Testing Fee Form to pay your \$20 HACC Proctoring fee in the Welcome Center.
 - b.) After paying your \$20 proctoring fee, please bring your form and receipt back to the Testing Office to be added to the Test Center schedule. (Sorry – we cannot accommodate same day appointments.)
3. Your appointment will be confirmed via email.
4. To cancel or reschedule, please email the Learning Center staff at lanctestcenter@hacc.edu.

You must reschedule within 30 days or you will be required to pay the \$20 HACC proctoring fee again.

- Bring a form of Government ID, to the Testing Center – MAIN, Room232E.
- Visit <http://clep.collegeboard.org>, create account (top right), find the CLEP exam that you want to take, add to the shopping cart, and then click register and checkout. On the date of your exam, you must bring your printed voucher along with you.
- Unofficial score reports are provided on the day of the exam. Exam scores for tests requiring essays are not available for 2 to 3 weeks. Please ask the proctor for approximate score mailing dates.
