Special Notes:

- 1) **Courses for Millersville University have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and MU based on current academic year. Curricula are subject to change. It is the students' responsibility to speak with their advisor for any changes or updates.**
- 2) 0-level courses do **not** count toward graduation credits and they do **not** transfer.
- 3) ***BSE Education majors are encouraged to take CIS 109, ENGL 201-207 (select one), PSYC 101, and PSYC 212 and are required to have two math courses (depending upon major) for the degree at MU. You may take these courses at HACC in addition to your HACC AA degree requirements and transfer 67 cr. toward your degree at MU. Minimum preferred GPA for Educ. Majors: 3.0.**
- 4) You will also need to pass the PAPA Test before you can be admitted to the Education Advanced Professional Studies at MU. **Students are strongly encouraged to complete the PAPA Test prior to 45 credits.** Students must also have satisfactory Act 34 (Criminal Record Check), Act 114 (FBI Fingerprint), and Act 151 (Child Abuse) reports.
- 5) The above courses complete not only HACC requirements, but also Millersville general education requirements, major requirements and/or writing specific areas. It is in your best interest to take the recommended courses.
- 6) Admissions is competitive so apply **early**: Fall application recommended deadline - Feb 1 (must include transcript)
Spring application recommended deadline - September 1 (must include transcript)
