Overview of Shippensburg University's General Education Program

The General Education Program at Shippensburg University Comprises forty-eight of the credit hours required for graduation.

-Part 1: ^RRequired Skills and Competencies (Basic Skills Requirements) 15 credits

- This specific set of courses is required to be completed by all students
- ENG 114, HCS 100, College Level Math, HIS 105, HIS 106

-Part 2: Categories of Knowledge

- ^ACategory A Logic & Numbers for Rational Thinking (1 course – 3 credits)
- ^BCategory B Linguistic, Literary, Artistic, & Cultural Traditions (3 courses – 9 credits)
- ^CCategory C Biological & Physical Sciences (3 courses – 9 credits)
- ^DCategory D Political, Economic, and Geographic Sciences (2 courses – 6 credits)
- ^ECategory E Social and Behavioral Sciences (2 courses – 6 credits)

SPECIAL NOTES (IMPORTANT, PLEASE READ)

1. Additional transfer credits may be taken at HACC for transfer to Shippensburg. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer counselor for advisement on additional coursework.
2. Communication Journalism at SU has a 2.3 cumulative GPA entrance requirement and allows for 29 free electives. Human Communication Studies at SU has a 2.0 cumulative GPA entrance requirement and allows for 33 free elective electives. 0-Level courses do not count toward graduation requirements and will not transfer. FS courses may not transfer.
3. Courses for Shippensburg University have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and SU. However, curricula are subject to change. Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer counselor if you have any questions. A transfer counselor from SU visits the Wildwood campus on a bi-weekly basis through the academic year. Call the SU Office of Admissions for the specific day and time.
4. B.A. students must satisfy the Novice level competency in a foreign language. This is accomplished via 3 years of the same language in high school, an AP score of at least 2, or the completion of a 103 level course. Three credits of a foreign language may count under category B general education requirement.
5. As part of the COM 112: Media Writing course, a grammar/style proficiency exam is given to all students. This exam must be passed with a score of 70 or better to pass the course and stay in the major/minor. Students are permitted to take the exam no more than two times. **COM 112 (Media Writing) must be taken at Shippensburg University.**
