Transfer Institution: **York College of Pennsylvania**

Students wishing to transfer to York College in **Early Elementary Education or Early Elementary/Special Education (pk-4)** will not be able to earn their Associate's Degree at HACC without substantial loss of credit. The following courses have been selected in consultation with York College. **Students are advised to take only these courses, as others will not transfer in this major.**

Admission into York College's Education program is not granted automatically. Students are admitted provisionally. The following requirements are necessary to gain Professional Status. **Failure to meet all requirements outlined will result in the student needing to spend additional time at York College in Pre-Professional Educator Status prior to being able to move into Professional Status:**

- satisfactory **Pre-Professional Academic Performance Assessment (PAPA)** scores (It is recommended to take these tests prior to the completion of 45 credits)
- completion of the required major courses with B grades or higher
- **completion of ECH 200 and ECH 210 with B grades or higher; taken at York College (contact York College for course offerings and process for enrolling in this class prior to officially transferring)**
- satisfactory Act 34 (Criminal Record Check), Act 151 (Child Abuse Report), and Act 114 (FBI Fingerprint Clearance)

Special Notes:

1. Courses for YCP have been selected by joint agreement of HACC and YCP. However, curricula are subject to change. It is in your best interest to meet with your advisor and talk to the transfer counselor at YCP if you have any questions about your courses.
2. Students taking 30+ transferrable credits are exempt from the First Year Seminar (FYS*) at YCP and granted 3 additional credits of elective. Engl 101 may be used for this elective.
3. Students are advised to **apply one semester prior** to desired transfer date. Required cumulative transfer GPA is 2.0.
4. 0-Level courses **do not** count toward graduation requirements and **will not transfer**. FS courses will not transfer.
5. In cases where two classes transfer as the same equivalency to YCP, only one may be taken for transfer, i.e GEOG 201 or 230.
