The York Campus currently has 263 students enrolled in secondary programs to include College in the High School, Dual Enrollment and HACC Academy.

59 of York's College in the High School students were awarded \$6,300 in tuition scholarships this fall! The HACC Foundation and the Office of Secondary Partnerships offer financial assistance to high school students who wish to enroll in a Concurrent Enrollment Program at

HACC. Students are eligible if recipients of free/reduced lunch, residing in a single income household, and/or a child or step child of a current or former member of the United States military.

York currently offers a College in the High School HORT 101 course at Northern High School. During my recent visit to the class, high school security staff were attempting to wrangle a raccoon from the compost pile.

## Recycling at the York Campus

The facilities department at the York Campus cleaned house (warehouse that is) during September. After several campus renovations, many unusable items were stacked in the warehouse creating a need for more space. This need gave facilities staff, Jackie and Todd, the idea to "go scrapping." Combing the nooks and crannies for scrap they found, aluminum (115 lbs), copper (85 lbs), brass (4 lbs), copper wire (126 lbs) and iron/steel (2400 lbs). Next stop--the scrap yard!

As they say, "one person's scrap is another person's treasure" and HACC's treasure totaled \$571.00. This project accomplished four tasks: gained funds for future campus projects, acquired extra warehouse space, activated green recycling and developed quality team building moments.
