	Allegation of academic dishonesty. Examples include: cheating, plagiarism, etc. Report received by: Associate Provost	<ul> <li>Adjudicated by Associate Provost and/or Academic Deans</li> <li>Often defer to faculty syllabus (grade reduction, F for the course, etc.)</li> <li>Repeat offenders can be additionally sanctioned accordingly under SGP 506</li> </ul>
DISCIPLINARY	Allegation of policy violation. Examples include: theft, harassment, vandalism, etc.	<ul> <li>Investigated and adjudicated by Director of Student Conduct or designee</li> <li>Investigation, sanctioning, hearings, and</li> </ul>

## DOCUMENTING ONLY

Out of character behavior or lower level concerning behavior. Often addressed by staff in the moment. No additional follow-up needed. Additional notes added to Maxient case file
