



Position Description, Student Member, HACC Foundation Board

Title: Student Member, HACC Foundation Board
Responsible to: HACC Foundation Board of Directors
Term of office: One year

Qualifications:

- Must be a full-time credit student, in good standing, enrolled at the College at the time of appointment (*A student in good standing is one with a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.0 and who is not on academic probation*)
- Must be a degree-seeking student and not employed at the institution
- Must commit to fulfilling the duties of the position for the length of the term
- Must commit to email and online communication

Responsibilities:

- Serve as a non-voting member of the HACC Foundation Board for a one-year term and shall be eligible to be elected for up to two additional one-year terms
- Advance the HACC Foundation's mission and vision statements
- Raise a minimum of \$1,000 annually from HACC students to include a personal contribution from the student member of the HACC Foundation Board
- Serve as an "ambassador" of the College and the HACC Foundation at public events and/or within the student's own networks
- Serve on at least one Foundation committee
- Attend 50 percent of the regular Board meetings per year
- Attend HACC Foundation and College events and functions throughout the year, when possible
- Sign conflict of interest and confidentiality policy statements
