it's all too common these days, is an opiate overdose. We can place the mannequin in a corner of our simulation lab

it's all wireless it's, uh, it bluetooths to the instructors laptop and they control it

from the control room away from the students and they would then have to assist the mannequin with breathing administer,

**CRAIG DAVIS**

you probably are familiar with, narcan, the medicine that's given.

[Cut to moving shot of students rolling sim man through hallway while performing CPR]

The mannequin is revived or resuscitated and then move the mannequin over to

our ambulance simulator and very much like the

transport of patient to the hospital.
