Goal: \$250,000

HACC's Gettysburg Campus provides access to higher education for many people who would otherwise struggle to go to college. Only 23 percent of residents in our community have received associate degrees. Many studies have shown a correlation between increasing educational attainment and decreasing incidences of poverty, unemployment, incarceration and reliance on public assistance.

Business Administration is the campus' largest transfer degree program, and Business Management and Business Studies are our second and third largest career degree programs.
