Harrisburg Campus Scholarship Fund for Pell Grant Ineligible Students

An estimated 30 percent of the campus' student population does not qualify for the federal Pell Grant option. This general scholarship fund will enable the Harrisburg Campus to attract top-notch students and give current students who are ineligible for federal aid another option to finance their education.

Harrisburg Promise Scholarship

This scholarship assists first-year, financially disadvantaged students who have successfully participated in the Harrisburg Promise program. Students in the program must maintain a 2.5 GPA throughout high school, live in the designated school districts and participate in all other program requirements.
