

**Background Requirements**  
**Prior to Starting the Clinical Portion of the Program**  
**(After acceptance)**

Additional information and required forms will be provided to you upon acceptance into clinical. Failure to provide all the necessary documentation before the established deadline could lead to denial of admission into the clinical program. The following must be completed (**at your own expense**) after you have been selected for, but prior to starting the clinical portion of the program:

**Physical Examination and Required Immunizations**

All students accepted into the clinical component of the program must submit a health examination form completed by a physician/nurse practitioner/physician's assistant with immunization history including verification through blood work. No student will be admitted with a disqualifying result or failure to meet the specified deadline.

**Background Checks**

All students accepted into the clinical component of the program must undergo annual Pennsylvania Child Abuse History Clearance, FBI Check and State Police Criminal Record Check. No student will be admitted with a disqualifying criminal history or child abuse clearance. Students with criminal backgrounds interested in admission into the clinical portion of any health career program at HACC, must follow the Prohibitive Offense Procedure for Health Career Programs and schedule a meeting with the Program Director to discuss.

**Drug and Alcohol Screens**

All students accepted into the clinical component of the program must undergo a drug and alcohol screen annually at the laboratory specified by the program on or before the stated deadline. This lab is used to protect the integrity of the results being reported. No student will be admitted or retained in the program with a disqualifying result or failure to meet the specified deadline.

**Any candidate not meeting these criteria will be denied admission into the program.**

## Clinical Schedules

The clinical day is 8.5 hours long (with a ½ hour lunch), scheduled between 7 a.m. to 6 p.m. during most rotations with four weeks of 1 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. rotations during the last 2 semesters.

### **Scheduled Clinical Days – current schedule - subject to change**

**Spring** - Three 8.5-hour days per week (Includes 1/2 hr. lunch), currently Wed., Thurs., & Fri.

**Summer** - Three 8.5-hour days per week (Includes 1/2 hr. lunch), currently Mon., Tues., Wed.

**Fall** - Three 8.5-hour days per week (Includes 1/2 hr. lunch), either Mon., Tues., & Wed., or Wed., Thur., & Fri.

**Spring** - Three 8.5-hour days per week (Includes 1/2 hr. lunch), currently Mon., Tues., Wed. Clinical rotations in this semester include two weeks of evening hours 1-9:30 p.m.

**Summer** - Four 8.5-hour days per week (Includes 1/2 hr. lunch), currently Tues., Wed., Thur., Fri) Clinical rotations in this semester include two weeks of evening hours 1-9:30 p.m.

## **HACC Radiologic Technology Clinical Sites**

Placements for clinical are based on the following considerations:

Every attempt is made to keep students from driving greater than 1 hour to the clinical sites within the clinical site grouping. The driving time is calculated utilizing google maps based on the listed physical address of the student and the clinical site address.

To avoid having any student drive greater than 1 hour to the clinical sites in their grouping, another student may be required to drive to a clinical site that is not the closest to their home.

All clinical site are grouped as follows. Students are assigned to a single clinical site **group** (one of 5) and rotate to **all the sites within that group**. See key to abbreviations below.
