



Tactical Medical Practitioner (TMP)[®]

This 82 - hour blended course is designed for EMS and medical professionals who are interested in expanding their skills and knowledge in the tactical medicine discipline. The Tactical Medical Practitioner[®] course (TMP)[®] is designed to prepare pre-hospital providers to function more competently and effectively on a tactical team. Mixing current military medicine with progressive pre-hospital concepts, this course offers a unique perspective on caring for the injured in austere environments. This course is developed with the tactical provider in mind, transitioning the focus from traditional EMS operations, to those necessary to better care for the patients encountered in a tactical setting. Students of this course will gain valuable knowledge and skills needed to function in limited and austere environments and learn valuable skills in prolonged field care, extrication, and technical rescue. This course prepares students to think and function critically, function autonomously and maintain mission focus. This course's focus is to produce world class medical providers who may operate on a tactical team, this course will not provide officer/operator level tactics.

This course is 5 days in duration with one extended training day until 12:00am and waterborne training event. Attendance at each session is mandatory.

Pre-requisites: *Participant must hold a current healthcare certification, at or above the EMT level to include mid level providers and physicians (EMT, RN, PA/NP, MD, DO, ATP). Based on registration numbers, priority will be given to those students who provide proof of affiliation to an operational medical or tactical team.*

Upon completion, students will receive the NAEMT Tactical Emergency Casualty Care certification and be prepared to take the Certified Tactical Paramedic (TP-C)[®] exam by the Board of Critical Care Transport Paramedic Certification/ International Board of Specialty Certification
