



Task Force Safety Officer (TFSO)

Description: This course is designed to provide Urban Search and Rescue (US&R) Task Force personnel with the knowledge, skills, and abilities necessary to perform the duties of a Task Force Safety Officer (TFSO) on a US&R task force. This course is 25 hours of face to face training, meeting over three days.

Course topics: Will include: Risk Management, Roles and Responsibilities of the US&R Task Force Safety Officer, Normalization of Deviance, Risk Factors, Hazard Mitigation, Risk Reduction, Real World Scenario's

Prerequisite: Prior to attending this face-to-face training course, students must successfully complete the Computer-Based Training (CBT) portion of this course that is approximately 5 hours. Login directions will be provided upon registration.
