I. Request For Bid

HACC's Shumaker Public Safety Center at the direction of the College president is formally requesting a Bids for Law Enforcement Patrol Training Weapons. The two components of this request for bids will be reviewed as one project. The trade-in allowance or sale will be factored into the overall cost of project for the purchase of replacement weapons to arrive at the lowest cost or highest return.

II. General Background

The mission of the Senator John J. Shumaker Public Safety Center is to provide premier public safety training in a responsive, efficient, economical and professional manner. Specifically, the Law Enforcement Training Unit Mission is: *To provide outstanding law enforcement training that is economical, professional, responsive and efficient. To this end we value quality, safety, competency, proficiency and customer satisfaction.*

The Harrisburg Area Community College Law Enforcement Training Unit enjoys the fine reputation of being one of the best law enforcement training facilities in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. We are a certified Municipal Police Academy, Act 120 via the Municipal Police Officers' Education and Training Commission (MPOETC). We are also certified by the Pennsylvania State Police as a certified training facility for Lethal Weapons Training, Act 235, a program primarily designed for security officers.

Our new Law Enforcement Training Complex is scheduled for completion the end of June, 2012 and will include administrative offices, "smart" classrooms, an armory and a state-of-the-art twenty-five (25) point indoor firing range. As a direct result of constructing this modern facility, we anticipate increasing and expanding firearms training programs. A few key factors over our present outdoor range are adverse weather conditions will not impact on scheduling, we will have twenty-five firing points instead of fifteen (15) and the new range will accommodate patrol rifle and other high powered tactical team weapons training. Patrol rifles are the upcoming modern-day weapons adopted by numerous police departments to be carried in patrol units. Our present outdoor range is only designed for pistols and shotguns.

For the reasons stated above, we are in the process of updating our weaponry in order to enhance law enforcement training programs. The weapons we are requesting to trade or sell are no longer the primary law enforcement training weapons used today.

III Format for Bid

A. Qualifications

Bidders must be a Licensed Federal Firearms Dealer and comply with Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Licensed Dealer regulations. It is expected that the successful bidder will be able to handle all paperwork required for this transaction in compliance with all regulations and laws governing the transfer, sale and purchase of weapons with the college.
