How do I order my course materials, and will the bookstores be open this fall? The list of required and optional course materials for fall 2021 is available on the bookstore website, bookstore.hacc.edu.

If materials are not yet listed for a specific course, please check back frequently, as materials are being added daily. Financial aid will be available to use for the fall 2021 semester on Aug. 9, 2021.

Please note the following:

- Starting Aug. 1, 2021, there will be a \$4.95 shipping fee for each order shipped via UPS. Customers placing a web order will have the option to pick up their order at any campus bookstore during open store hours, which start Aug. 16, 2021.
- There is no longer a bookstore located on the Lebanon Campus. However, customers can pick up their orders at the Learning Commons Desk located on the third floor of the Lebanon Campus.
- All orders for textbooks and other course materials should be placed online through the fall 2021 semester. Not all textbooks and other course materials will be available to purchase at all campus bookstore locations.
- School and office supplies and HACC-imprinted merchandise (such as clothing and gift items) will be available to purchase at all campus bookstore locations.
- Apple[®] products will be available to purchase in the Harrisburg Campus bookstore or online.
- Textbooks and other required course materials need to be pre-ordered even if you choose in-store pickup.

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
