Please allow me to provide clarification on the [March 10, 2021, announcement](#) regarding the fall 2021 semester:

1. In fall 2021, classes will be taught in a **variety of ways** – on campus and through remote instruction and virtual learning. Please see details under the “How will course instruction be offered in the fall 2021 semester?” section of [this website](#).
2. Our campuses will be open only to **students and employees approved to be on campus** for courses and scheduled appointments for select student services.
3. We will **increase** the number of on-campus classes offered in fall 2021.
4. We will bring **select student services** back on campus for YOUR convenience.
5. The campuses will **remain closed to the general public** until at least Dec. 20, 2021.
