


How to Login to Azure Dev Tools for Teaching Portal


- 1- Go to <https://azureforeducation.microsoft.com/devtools> and click the 'Sign In' button.





8- Click on the software you wish to download to select it (i.e.: Project Professional 2019 shown on screenshot example below) then click the **'View'** button to view the software product key. **Save the product key as you will be required to enter it in order to activate the software once it's installed.**

9- Then click the **'Download'** button at the bottom right corner of the screen to download the selected software.

***Please note most Microsoft software downloads will produce an .ISO image file and it will require you to burn the file into a disc in order to install it.


