Students prepare to become self-employed as auctioneers or are employed at an auction site. This program is approved by the Pennsylvania State Board of Auctioneer Examiners as meeting the educational course requirements necessary to sit for the Auctioneer License Examination. *Note: There is a mandatory 60-hour practicum with a PA licensed auctioneer that may include participation in auctioneering activities at a physical site.* This diploma may be completed entirely through asynchronous instruction.

Career Opportunities

Upon completion of the specialty auctioneering courses and passing the Pennsylvania State Auctioneer License Examination the graduate becomes a Licensed Auctioneer. (SOC Code: 41-9099 Sales and Related Workers, All Others)
