- ^ECategory E Social and Behavioral Sciences (2 courses – 6 credits)

Please speak with your advisor and/or the SU transfer advisor if you have any questions. A transfer advisor from Shippensburg University visits the Wildwood campus on a biweekly basis throughout the academic year.
