Now more than ever, we must come together to demonstrate compassion, professionalism and unity for our students and one another. Please take time to care for yourself and be mindful of the needs of those around you. Your resilience and commitment embody what it means to *reimagine employee success together* - supporting each other, serving our students with excellence and strengthening our shared purpose as a college community.
